Previously published example:

- Germ-averse individuals are less likely to be risk takers
- Perceived susceptibility to infection does not affect propensity to take risks
- Priming individuals with a disease threat leads to less risk taking
- Negative emotion mediates between disease threat salience and tendency to take risks
- Future research: Does contagious disease threat increase conservative attitudes and conformance to the norm?
